## The Cross is the Foundation for Every Believer's Call

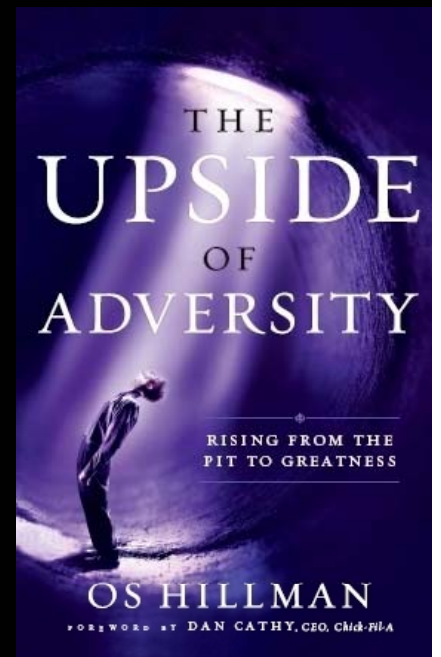



## Early signs you are experiencing the cross

- “Why am I going through this?”
- “This makes no sense, God. I’m not in sin! Why is this happening to me?”
- “My world is falling apart.”
- “I feel like I’m in a freefall and have nothing to hang onto. I can’t control anything.”
- “It’s not true! How could they think such lies!?”
- “How could he/she betray me like this?”

- **Black Hole – out of control**
- **Desert – isolation**
- **Restoration - fulfillment**






God gives us the cross, and





**The Pilgrim's Progress was a book that could only have been written by a soul that was refined by the fires of adversity.**







## Cross becomes your authority


Walking successfully through your season of the cross gives you the authority to minister the message God deposits into your life during that season.

The level of adversity always corresponds to the level of call. This defines the depth and width of the ministry He plans through your life.

# Get all God desires for you to get

- It is very important to get all the jewels of the process of the cross He takes you through.
- Don't extricate yourself
- It is what you gain in your cross experience that will determine the fruit.

## Michael Molinos, 1600s

“The first darkness is that which comes from sin. It is a darkness that is filled with unhappiness and leads the Christian to eternal death. The second kind of darkness is darkness which the Lord allows within our inward part in order to establish and settle virtue.

This is a happy darkness because it illuminates your inward spirit, strengthens it and gives it greater light. I would have you see these times of darkness as a happy darkness, a darkness in which you should persevere in your inward pursuit.”



## Michael Molinos, 1600s

“It is a manifest sign that God, in His infinite mercy, is seeking to bring you into the inward path. How good will be the results, dear friend, if you will but simply embrace these times with grace and with resignation! Such times are for your spiritual good. **These times of darkness do not slow you down in your journey toward Him! They may seem to, but in fact they hasten you toward the final point of your journey”**




## **Overcoming is not always good**

**Hos 5:15**

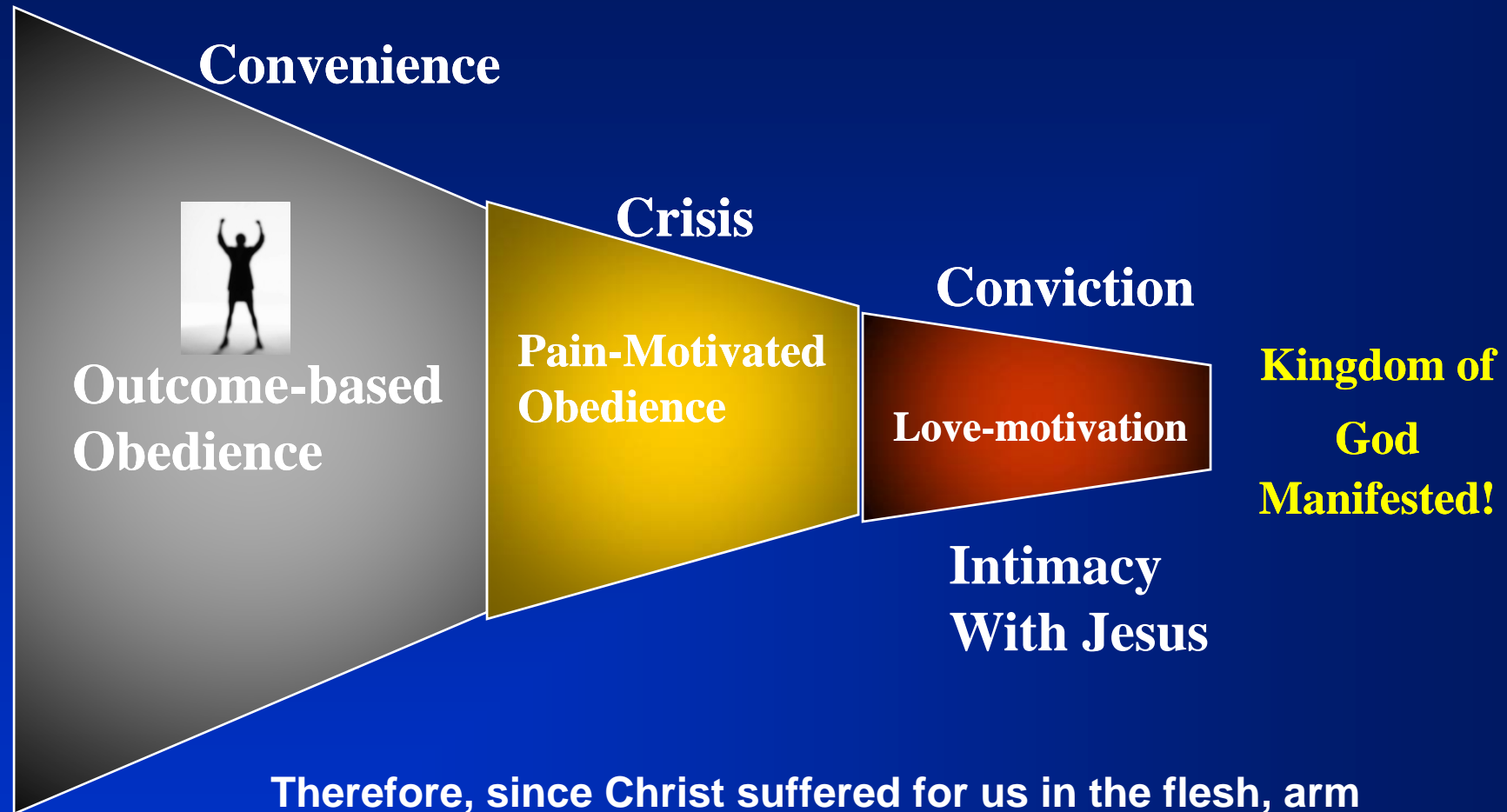

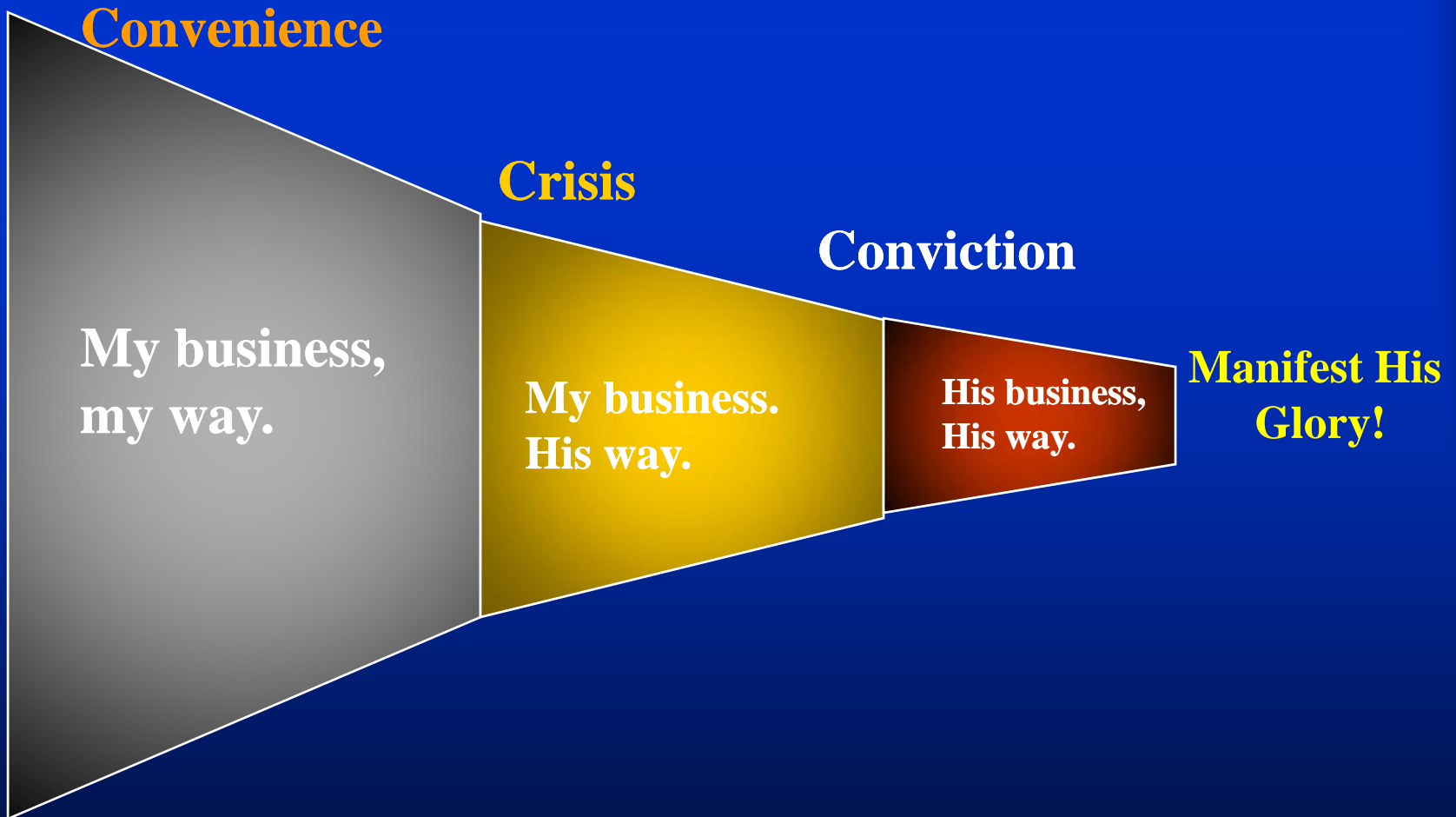


# 3 Phase Obedience Cycle



- He spent his third 40 years discovering what God can do with a nobody.“





## **Embracing the Cross is a Key to Nation Transformation**

# Indicators

# Joseph's Two Pits

1. **Betrayed by family** - Slave, servant, Potiphar's house
2. **Wrongfully accused, imprisoned in a dungeon** – rejected, abandoned, forgotten

Bad to worse!




# Failure and Calling



**Failure is one of the major tools God uses to learn the lessons of the cross.**

**God wants to crucify the success model most of us operate from**

- **Abraham failed to wait for the promised son.**
- **Moses attempted deliverance of his people through the Egyptian model**
- **David failed by committing adultery and murder**
- **Peter failed to love Jesus and denied Him three times.**



God will use failure in your life to break down that strong desire in your heart to see your name in lights. And when he finally breaks you of that lust for recognition, He may place you before the lights like you never imagined.

**Joseph probably could have cared less that he was elevated to the position of second in command to Pharaoh. He had become dead to his situation and was simply motivated by his obedience to God.**



# Abraham Lincoln

- Failed in business at 31.
- Defeated for legislature at 33.
- Again failed at business at 33.
- Elected to legislature at 34.
- Sweetheart died at 35. Nervous breakdown at 43.
- Defeated for Congress at 46.
- Defeated for Congress at 48.
- Elected President of the United States at 51.

## Oswald Chambers

When God gives a vision and darkness follows, waiting on God will bring you into accord with the vision He has given if you await His timing.

Otherwise, you try to do away with the supernatural in God's undertakings.

Never try to help God fulfill His word.



## The Cross Means Moving in God's Timing

- David waited for God to elevate him to be king and willed himself to wait for God's perfect timing for God to fulfill His promise to him.
- Jesus waited for the right timing to fulfill his purpose. His followers wanted him to fulfill a purpose that was not God's purpose.

# Samuel Morse

- **Born in 1791**
- **Morse grew up desiring to be an artist,**
- **it was difficult to make a living as an artist in America during that time.**
- **Wife died; then his mother and father also died soon after.**
- **He went to Europe to paint and reflect on his life. On his return trip aboard a ship, he was captivated by discussions at dinner about new experiments in electromagnetism.**

# Samuel Morse

- **During that important occasion, Morse made the following comment, "If the presence of electricity can be made visible in any part of the circuit, I see no reason why intelligence may not be transmitted by electricity."**
- **In the face of many difficulties and disappointments, he determinedly perfected a new invention, and, in 1837, applied for a patent that became what we know today as the telegraph. He also created Morse code. It was only later, after many more setbacks and disappointments, that his projects received funding.**

- “ I will wait patiently for the direction of Providence.”
  - Morse went on to create several other inventions and can be recognized today as the father of faxes, modems, e-mail, the internet and other electronic communication.

## Paul's perspective on his cross


We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed. We always carry around in our body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be revealed in our body (2 Cor. 4:8-10).

## Gal 2:20-21

I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

When you have too much self-will or no accountability, the cross has not been applied to that area of your life.





All that is not of Him must be  
crucified on the cross for His life to  
be fully realized through us.

# Addictions

## 2 Cor 12:9-11





# Viewing Failure/Brokenness

- It often takes a crisis to force us to examine ourselves.
- God doesn't test us in order to find out something He doesn't already know. He tests us so that we can learn about ourselves and His love, power and faithfulness.
- If you hope to succeed, learn everything you can from your failures and brokenness.
- God sees failure as preparation for success.
- Our lives are framed by the events and experiences that God takes us through, and our lives are defined by how we respond.

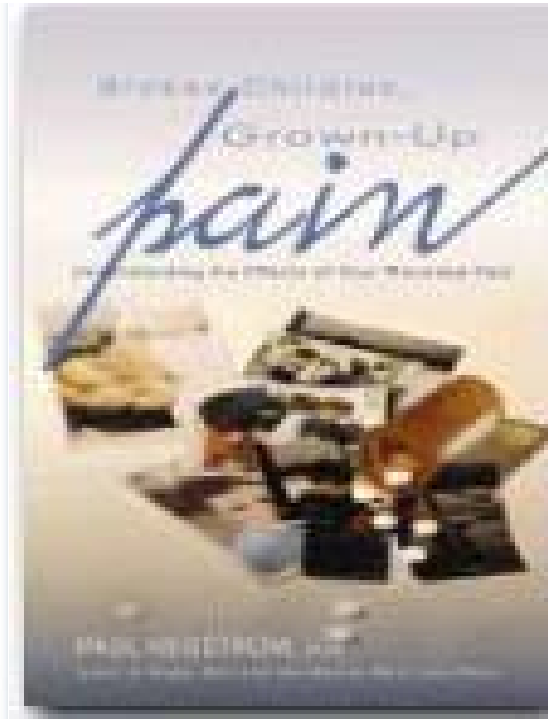
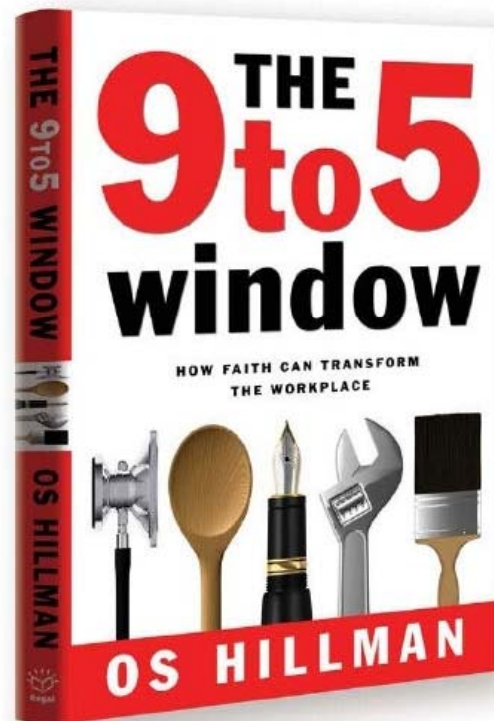
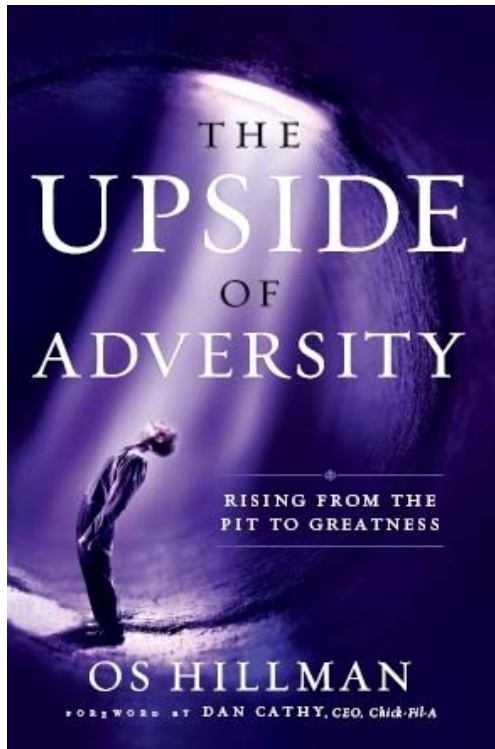
